REGIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM (RTP) FOR SECONDARY SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS

To: Regional Directors

Schools Superintendents

- 1. Pursuant to the long-term goals and action plans of the Package Cooperation-Assisted Science and Mathematics Education (SME) INSET program of DECS, a 12-day Seminar-Workshop on the Practical Work Approach (PWA) in Teaching Science and Mathematics will be conducted in the regions in April to May, 1999.
- 2. The training program intends to introduce the concept and methodologies of the Practical Work Approach as a teaching strategy in Science and Mathematics. The workshop further provides practical demonstration in the processes of adapting existing lessons and instructional materials to local classroom situations.
- 3. As a major component of the SME Regional Training Program (RTP), the seminar-workshop shall be conducted at the regional training centers and managed by the Regional Management Team (RMT), in coordination with UP-ISMED and DOST through the Regional Science Teaching Centers (RSTCs) in the regions. The training staff is composed of the UP-ISMED-trained DECS regional and divisional trainors, RSTC-based trainors and Japanese subject experts.
- 4. For this summer, the participants are 160 high school Science and Mathematics teachers per region distributed as follows:

40 Mathematics 1 and 2

40 Chemistry

40 Mathematics 3 and 4

40 Physics

- 5. Thirty percent of the total expenses incident to the conduct of the training will be subsidized by Central Office funds, the remaining 70% are chargeable against local INSET funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
