CONFERENCE ON ACADEMIC LIBRARIANSHIP IN A TRANSFORMATIONAL
AGE: PROGRAMS AND PROSPECTS

To: Regional Directors

Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Philippine Association of Academic and Research Libraries (PAARL) will hold a 3-day seminar workshop at Silliman University, Dumaguete City on April 6-8, 1999.
2. The theme of the Conference is "Academic Librarianship in a Transformational Age: Programs and Prospects." It aims to: a) train librarians in strategic planning for the next decade along the areas of library management, collection development, computerization and cooperation, and b) provide insights on the emerging realities of librarianship in the education environment for the next decade.
3. Participants to this seminar-workshop are librarians from both public and private elementary and secondary schools. Those coming from government/public schools may attend the Conference at the discretion of their respective Regional Directors/superintendents on official time only. Participants from private institutions shall make arrangements with their respective schools.
4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (P2,700.00) will be charged each participant to cover meals and accommodation for three days, use of Conference facilities, seminar kit, certificate, honoraria of speakers and other expenses.
