**FIFTH NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION
 OF TEACHERS OF CULTURE AND THE ARTS**

1. The Philippine Association of Teachers of Culture and the Arts (PATCA) will hold its Fifth National Conference with the theme, "Humanities and Science: An Aesthetic Coexistence in the Academe," at the Audio Visual Room, Philippine Normal University, Taft Avenue, Manila on April 23-24, 1999.
2. The convention aims to: a) impress upon the teachers of culture and the arts that Science and the Humanities are mutually reinforcing fields in the teaching of General Education subjects; b) devise ways and methods/strategies in the teaching of General Education subjects using the scientific-humanistic approach; and c) define the scientific-humanistic approach in the teaching of culture and general education courses.
3. Participants to this convention are elementary and high school teachers handling humanities and arts courses.
4. The convention fee of Nine Hundred Fifty Pesos (P950.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for registration, conference kit and materials, and certificates of appearance and participation. For participants from government/public institutions, attendance to this convention shall be allowed, depending on their needs, on official time only. Those coming from private institutions shall make arrangements with their respective institutions.
