21st ANNUAL NATIONAL CMLI SUMMER CONFERENCE AND WORKCAMP

- 1. The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI), announces the conduct of its 21st CMLI Annual National Summer Conference and Workcamp of the Junior Members and Teacher-Advisers at Tabaco National High School, Tabaco, Albay from April 24 to May 02, 1999.

Those coming from private schools shall make arrangements with their respective schools.
