8TH SOUTHEAST ASIAN CONFERENCE ON MATHEMATICS EDUCATION
"MATHEMATICS FOR THE 21ST CENTURY"

1 The Philippine Council of Mathematics Teacher Educators (MATHTED), Inc and the Mathematics Department of the Ateneo de Manila University, in cooperation with the Mathematical Society of the Philippines (MSP), the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines (MTAP), the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), and the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) will be sponsoring the 8TH Southeast Asian Conference on Mathematics Education (SEACME-8) with the theme, *Mathematics for the 21ST Century*, on 30 May - 4 June, 1999 at the Ateneo de Manila University, Loyola Heights, Quezon City

2 This is the second time that the Philippines is hosting SEACME. The first SEACME was held in June 1978. As in SEACME 1, the conference will feature scholarly papers, group discussions, workshops, and poster displays presented by local mathematics educators, as well as educators from Singapore, Thailand, Brunei, Japan, Australia, U.K., U.S.A., and other countries.

3 The conference will deal with the current interests, trends, and issues related to curricular methods and strategies at the elementary, secondary, and university levels.

4 A registration fee of ₱3,000.00 for the 5-day conference will be charged each Filipino/local participant and US\$200.00 each foreign participant. Local participants who will also attend the MATHTED '99 Conference on May 29 will be charged ₱3,400.00 for the two conferences. This fee will cover materials as well as morning and afternoon snacks and lunches for the duration of the Conference.

5 Participants are advised of Item No. 4 of D.O. No. 6, s. 1999 which states: *Teachers and administrators are free to attend such workshops but with no funding from DECS or the Regional Office.*
