NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

1 The Philippine Normal University (PNU), the Peace and World Order Studies Unit (PWOSU) and the UNESCO Associated Schools Project (UNESCO ASP), announce the holding of the National Conference on International Education at the Philippine Normal University Audio Visual Theatre on April 21-22, 1999

2 The theme of the Conference is "Learning for One World: Issues and Perspectives". It aims to, among others, provide a forum for the exchange of ideas in promoting international education as a means of developing effective citizenship in a global and multicultural society.


3 Expected participants to this Conference are elementary and secondary Social Studies teachers and supervisors, UNESCO ASP coordinators and UNESCO club advisers.
