**SECOND PESPA-BEE PRINCIPALS CONGRESS**

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Private Elementary School Principals

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) and the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) will hold its second PESPA-BEE Principals Congress at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City on May 12-14, 1999. The theme will be "The Principals' Meeting the Challenges of Education in the New Millennium".
2. The Congress aims to strengthen the management and leadership competencies of elementary school principals to meet the challenges of the new millennium. It further aims to take a closer look on the major issues and concerns facing the school managers in creating a preferred school scenario. This is to effect desired changes and improvement in administration and supervision. Inclosed is a list of topics to be discussed.
3. Participants will include PESPA officers and board members, public and private elementary school principals and head teachers. PESPA officers are expected to be at the venue a day before the Congress.
4. A registration fee of four thousand pesos (P4,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for food, accommodation, honoraria of speakers, conference materials, kit and other incidental expenses chargeable against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The schools may also explore local donors or sponsors to subsidize expenses for attendance to the Congress.
