CONSTEL SCIENCE VIDEOTAPES PROHIBITED AS STUDENTS' PROJECT

Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

- 1. Reports have reached this Office that the CONSTEL videotapes are required as projects by teachers of some private schools.
- The CONSTEL Science learning materials are designed to upgrade the teachers' competencies in teaching Science; hence, it is inappropriate for teachers to require their students to submit these learning materials as projects.
- 3. To protect the authorized reproduction of the CONSTEL Science videotapes, DECS, UPISMED and PTNI strictly prohibit the copying, renting, editing, selling, re-transmission and public showing of the program without previous written permission from the program owners.
- 4. To acquire the CONSTEL videotapes with the Teacher Support Materials (TSM) the school head or principal shall have two options: to purchase a set of these videotapes or to ask a sponsoring agency to donate a set of these materials to the school.
- 5. Guidelines for acquiring CONSTEL Science learning materials are provided in DECS Order No. 21, s. 1999.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is expected.
