**TRAINING FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS HANDLING  
DEAF STUDENTS (HEARING IMPAIRED)**

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division Superintendents  
Secondary School Principals and Administrators of SPED Centers

1. The Christoffel Blindenmission (CBM) in cooperation with this Department will sponsor a 5-day live-in training for teachers of students with hearing impairment (HI) on May 3-7, 1999 at the Rizal Public School Teachers Association Bldg., Oranbo Drive, Pasig City.
2. At the end of the training, the participants shall have acquired knowledge and skills necessary in providing educational services to hearing impaired (HI) secondary school students. They should be able to:
  - a) offer a variety of special programs and services appropriate for secondary deaf students;
  - b) teach the different subject areas using sign languages; and
  - c) assess HI students for integration with the mainstream.

Attached herewith (Inclosure 1) is the line up of activities and topics to be taken up during the training.

3. Participants in this training program are teachers of selected schools with a HI program and teachers of prospective pilot schools for said impairment. The list of participants are shown in Inclosure 2.
4. Board and lodging shall be borne by the Christoffel Blindenmission while travel expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Participants are expected to register in the afternoon of May 2<sup>nd</sup> and check out in the afternoon of May 7<sup>th</sup>.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
