National Schools Press Conference  
Group Contests  
Elementary and Secondary Levels

Observations made by the judges on the group contests

- ♦ There are linguistic, literary and creative talents in the secondary schools in the country.
- ♦ The Top 10 best school papers have displayed -
  - ♦ Good writing
  - ♦ Good combination of stories
  - ♦ Good production values and varied styles
  - ♦ Best edited articles
- ♦ However, there are elements which need to be improved.
  - ♦ Grammar needs creative reworking in the articles written.
  - ♦ Contents of the articles must be focused on school activities and community-based activities. Less on national issues.
  - ♦ There is a need to use computer graphics to "dance with the times" of modernization.
  - ♦ There is a need to concentrate on "action" photos, and not on posed photos. Better and more alive shots are preferable.
  - ♦ Style and format must vary to avoid monotony.
  - ♦ More subject areas in science should be covered.
  - ♦ Minimize the use of too many type prints.
  - ♦ There is a need to employ other techniques for presenting news evidence.
  - ♦ Variety of content is needed.
  - ♦ A good selection of articles from other sources and citing these sources is very commendable.
  - ♦ Excessive use of highlights (background patterns) should be avoided.
  - ♦ There is elegance in simplicity of presentation. Few but quality and simplicity in presentation are preferable.

- ♦ Improved editing and proofreading must be achieved before printing.
- ♦ Featuring a more balanced selection of articles is most acceptable.
- ♦ Add more "heart and soul" or reflections in your writing.
- ♦ Add imagery, lightness and cheer in the articles.
- ♦ All elements of the school paper must form a cohesive whole that conveys the key messages of the school or community.
- ♦ Content and style of the school paper should mirror the thinking and sentiments of the school community, i.e. personalized writing.
- ♦ There is a need to refine the editorial and proofreading processes so that errors in grammar and concepts are spotted and corrected.
- ♦ There is a need to apply the principle of "less is more". Brief and substantial articles are preferable to give way for other stories/articles.
