FIRST NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS' CONFERENCE

- 1. The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (SCAAP), in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), will hold the National Science Club Advisers' Conference from April 20 24, 1999 at the La Vista Pansol Resort Complex, Pansol, Calamba, Laguna with the theme Science Clubbing: Gearing for the Next Millennium.
- 2. The conference is designed to reinvent the perspectives of the science club advisers in the various aspects of leadership and management in order to prepare them in coping up with the demands of science clubbing in the next millennium.
- 3. In view of the challenges posed by the coming new millennium, the conference aims to train the participants on aspects of leadership and management of the science club movement; instill in the participants a greater sense of commitment and action in saving the environment; and keep current to meet the dynamics of change inherent in the cyberage.
- 4. Participants to this activity are school science coordinators, science teachers, and science club advisers. A registration fee of Two Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (PhP 2,300.00) shall be charged each participant. Participants may seek the assistance of the local school board and/or various organizations to ensure maximum participation. The registration fee will cover expenses for accommodation, meals, educational tour, certificates, and other miscellaneous expenses.
