ANNOUNCING THE 1999 PNU SUMMER INSET PROGRAMS

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division Superintendents  
Heads of Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Philippine Normal University (PNU) will conduct a seven-day Training Course Packages for teachers in different subject areas in basic education for both public and private schools in April and May this year.

2. The PNU INSET Programs aim to provide quality training for in-service teachers. It will also serve as a continuing professional education program for the teachers, giving them an opportunity to meet the requirements for their license renewal, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7836 (Teacher Professionalization Law).

3. The program for 1999 is the first stage of a series of three (3) Levels to be conducted for three consecutive summer periods. Each Training Package may be credited for 3 graduate units or 54-hour credit equivalent to a course existing in the graduate programs of PNU, subject to fulfillment of admissions.


5. Training Fees for each participant are as follows:
