PROJECT: RESCUE INITIATIVES FOR SCIENCE EDUCATION (RISE)
Implementation of Third Batch of Training Program

To : Bureau Directors

1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) through the Bureau of Secondary Education and the Bureau of Elementary Education, the Commission on Higher Education, and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority announces the training program implementation of Project RISE for the third batch of trainees in summer 1999.
2. The objective of the project is to improve the competencies/capabilities of science and mathematics teachers in the elementary and secondary levels to enable them to teach more effectively and efficiently. A 180-hour teacher training program for teachers who are teaching the science and mathematics subjects in the said levels will be conducted in selected teacher training institutions in the country.
3. Participants to the training program are teachers of science and mathematics subjects. Priority shall be given to those who are non-majors but are teaching the subjects in the identified low performing schools throughout the country.
4. The participants will enjoy free training fee and shall be provided with stipend of six thousand pesos (P 6,000) for the duration of the training, book allowance of one thousand five hundred pesos (P 1,500) and the actual transportation allowance in going to the training venue and back (once only).

5. The training program shall be conducted in training centers identified by the Regional Technical Committees. A network within the region shall be organized involving the DOST Regional Offices, DECS Regional Offices, Regional Science Teaching Centers, Commission of Higher Education, Centers of Excellence, and Teacher Education Institutes. Details about the training program shall be provided by the training institution of the region.
6. Forms related to the requirements for participation to the training program may be secured from the Science Education Institute, Bicutan, Taguig, Metro Manila; DOST and DECS Regional Offices; DOST Provincial Offices; and the selected teacher training institutions nationwide.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
