TRAINING PROGRAM FOR MUSIC TEACHERS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Kodaly Society of the Philippines will hold a ten-day Training Program for Music Teachers at St. Paul College, Manila from April 26 to May 7, 1999.
2. The ten-day seminar aims to give adequate training to present and future music supervisors in Kodaly philosophy, Kodaly methodology, Philippine materials, choral singing and conducting. It also aims to involve the participants in research work, such as the collection of folk songs in their respective regions.
3. Participants shall be required to bring at least one folk rhyme, musical folk game or folk song for children in their dialect, plus translation into Pilipino or English for folk song sharing. Participants may bring the song already notated or just recorded on a tape.
4. A seminar fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P4,500.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for matriculation, seminar materials, lunch and snacks and membership fee in the Kodaly Society of the Philippines.
5. At the option of the Regional Directors, two participants per region may be allowed to attend the training program, on official time only.
