SEMINAR-WORKSHOP IN THE TEACHING OF GEOGRAPHY

Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Philippine Geographical Society will conduct the three-day Seminar-Workshop in the Teaching of Geography. Inclosed is the program of activities.

2. The Seminar-Workshops will focus on the basic lessons in Philippine Geography, address important issues on geography and relate its significance to economic development of the country. The participants shall also undertake sessions on planning instruction, writing/teaching exemplars and conducting demonstration lessons on basic geography.

5. A seminar fee of P3,000.00 shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for meals and snacks, seminar materials and one year membership fee in the Philippine Geographical Society. Attendance of participants from government institutions shall be

allowed, depending on their needs, on official time only. Those coming from the private schools shall make arrangements with their respective schools.
