**1999 EDUCATORS CONGRESS**

1. The 1999 *Educators Congress* will be held at the *Teachers Camp, Baguio City* on May 17-21, 1999 with the theme "*Revisiting the Classroom: Focus on the Teacher.*" This year's Congress shall focus on the Teacher as the most important factor in the teaching-learning process. The 1999 *Educators Congress* will discuss teacher development and the relevant areas of concern, namely : a) curriculum and learning; b) organizational arrangement ; and c) strategic direction.

2. Authorized to attend from the Central Office are all undersecretaries, assistant secretaries, bureau/center directors and assistant directors, heads of units/services/division and designated congress committee members.

Each regional office shall be represented by the regional director and assistant regional director, chiefs of the elementary, secondary, nonformal, physical education and school sports divisions, and regional finance, administrative, and information officers.

Each division shall likewise be represented by the schools division superintendents and assistant schools division superintendent/s and upon his/her discretion may also send five (5) division supervisors, five (5) school principals representing either the elementary or secondary levels and five (5) teachers representing the different learning areas.

3. Attendance to this Congress will be endorsed to the Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) for Continuing Professional Education (CPE) accreditation for the renewal of professional license.

4. The conference fee is Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00) to cover board and lodging, materials and conference kit.
