14TH ANNUAL DANCE EDUCATORS' CONVENTION WORKSHOP

1 The Dance Education Association of the Philippines (DEAP) is sponsoring the 14th Annual Dance Educators' Congress in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and the Commission on Higher Education to be held at the St. Mary's University, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya on May 17-22, 1999

2 The theme of the convention is **'Dance Empowerment Cultural Dance Traditions and Transformations'**

3 The objectives of the workshop are to

- discuss issues and concerns relevant to dance education in the school curriculum
- promote awareness of innovative strategies for effective quality teaching,
- analyze folk and ethnic dance movements that give them identity in the mainstream of Filipino culture
- choreograph dances to showcase dance traditions and transformations

One of the highlights of this national activity will be a free sight-seeing tour to BANAWE Rice terraces, and the experience of watching the 14 ethnic tribes of Nueva


Vizcaya in their ethnic costumes in a street dancing parade

4 Expected participants of the congress are physical education supervisors, administrators, department heads, teachers, coordinators and dances enthusiasts

5 A registration fee of one thousand eight hundred pesos (P1,800 00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for handout materials, honoraria for resource persons, 3 meals and 2 snacks everyday for five days, tapes for the dances, certificates and other expenses incident to the operation of the convention-workshop Participants from government agencies or institutions shall be on official time only Participants from private institutions shall make their own arrangement with their respective institutions Free accommodation will be provided
