GEARING UP RESOURCES FOR EFFECTIVE HEALTH CARE
DELIVERY FOR SY 1999 2000

1 In preparation for the opening of classes for SY 1999 2000 all school health and nutrition personnel are instructed to finalize work plans and take stock of available resources for a more effective delivery of health care to the school children/students teachers and non teaching personnel

2 The following activities deserve utmost priority

- a nutritional assessment of all children in pre schools, Grade I classes multigrade classes, and first year high school students
- b health examination and deworming of all recipients of the feeding program (fortified noodles, milk and indigenous foods),
- c orientation of the implementors of the School Feeding Program, and
- d treatment/referral of ailments found among the school children

3 School officials are enjoined to provide administrative support to the activities of the school health personnel Reports on such activities shall be submitted to the Health and Nutrition Center DECS Pasig City

4 Immediate dissemination and compliance with this Memorandum is desired
