WONDERS OF THE SEA

1 The Foundation for Resource Conservation, Inc. in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports will hold an environmental exhibit entitled "Wonders of the Sea" starting on July 1 to December 1999 at the Uniwide Coastal Mall, Baclaran, Paranaque. The exhibit will focus on one of the environmental issues that is of serious concern to all of us: the need to conserve marine resources.
