## DECS PHILSPADA REGIONAL SPORTS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

To Underse retaries/Assitant Secretaries Bureau/Regional Directors Schools Superintendents Private I lementary and Secondary School Principals

- Pursuant to DECS Memorandum No 9, s 1999, entitled Sports Development of Persons With Disabilities," the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and the Philippine Association of the Differently Abled (PHILSPADA) designed a comprehensive sports development program for differently abled individuals to wit the children and youth with visual impairment, hearing impairment, orthopedic impairment, mental disabilities and general learning problems. This will increase their opportunity to participate in sports, thus enhancing their excellence in this area
- 2 PHILSPADA in consultation with the DECS will conduct its First Regional Sports Development Program by region, schedule of which is contained in the inclosure
- Participants to this activity are twenty (20) athletes, four (4) coaches per disability group and twenty-eight (28) persons from each region as follows

- Schools with special education program, including special children who are mainstreamed in the regular classes are enjoined to participate and support this undertaking The DECS through the Bureau of Physical Education and School Sports (BPESS) shall provide financial assistance amounting to P25,000 00 per region and P50,000 00 subsidy for PHILSPADA operations
- The regional sports coordinator for the differently abled individuals should come up with the list of participants two weeks before the regional sports development program schedule
- Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired 6
