AN INTRODUCTION TO THE KODALY METHOD OF MUSIC TEACHING

To Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1 The Kodaly Society of the Philippines is holding a series of seminar workshops in Mindanao entitled "An Introduction to the Kodaly Method of Music Teaching". The first workshop will be held on July 14-16, 1999 at the Ateneo de Zamboanga, Purisima St, Zamboanga City, the second will be held on July 26-28, at the University of Mindanao, Bolton St, Davao City and the third workshop will be held on August 11-13, 1999 at Lourdes College, Capistrano St, Cagayan de Oro City.

2 The objective of these seminar workshops is to acquaint the participants with skills and techniques of the Kodaly Method.

3 Expected participants to this activity are music teachers, supervisors and choral conductors. Each participant will be required to bring at least one folk rhyme, a musical folk game or a folk song for children in his/her dialect plus its translation into Pilipino or English. They may bring the song already notated or just recorded on a tape.

4 Attendance of participants from government institutions may be allowed, depending on their needs, on official time only. Those coming from private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools.
