NATIONAL SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON NUTRITION EDUCATION AND
TECHNOLOGY

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Philippine Association of Extension Program Implementors (PAEPI) Inc. in cooperation with the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) and the University Extension Services (UES) will conduct a two day live out National Seminar Workshop on Nutrition Education and Technology at the Integrated Research and Training Center (IRTC) Bldg. TUP Manila on July 7-8, 1999.

2. The theme of this year's Nutrition Training Program is *Pagkaing Sapat Siguraduhin Wastong Nutrisyon Atng Kamtin*. It aims to increase awareness and understanding on food security in relation to good nutrition and be able to: a) intensify campaign on the selection and use of low cost but nutritious foods and dishes, b) apply food security measures that will make food available, accessible and affordable to the greater number of people, c) adopt appropriate food and nutrition technology that are health friendly and d) prepare an action that will support the agenda of food security and help solve the malnutrition problem of the country.

3. Participants in this training program are HE teachers, NFE workers, Extensionists, Daycare workers, Canteen managers, Nutrition educators, Social workers and other interested individuals.

4. A registration fee of Eight Hundred Pesos (P800.00) will be charged each participant to include handouts and snacks for two (2) days. Payment must be addressed in the name of PAEPI. Names of participants must be submitted to the Training Secretariat, UES Office, TUP Ayala Boulevard Ermita, Manila, Tel. Nos. 526 14 97 & 521 40 86.

5. Attendance of participants from government institutions may be allowed, depending on their needs on official time only. Participants from private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools.
