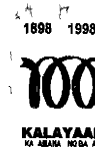

**ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR PRINCIPALS ON GRAFT
AND CORRUPTION PREVENTION EDUCATION AND

1 Based on the joint declaration of undertaking between the Department of Education, Culture and Sports and The Office of the Ombudsman towards developing the moral character of the Filipino youth and preparing them to become responsible citizens and future leaders of the country, the Staff Development Division, HRDS and the National Educators Academy of the Philippines in coordination with the Office of the Ombudsman, will conduct an orientation program for principals on Graft and Corruption Prevention Education in five clusters as follows



2 Participants will be provided instructions on the use of the teaching exemplars and graft and corruption prevention mechanisms. This will also serve as launching venues of the Graft and Corruption Prevention Education teaching exemplars which were developed through the collaborative efforts of both agencies. The principals are expected to form a trainers' group to conduct similar orientation among teachers on the concepts/values and processes adopted in the exemplars.

3 Each division is requested to send 8 participants ensuring that they come from different schools. They are expected to be at the venue in the afternoon of the day before the orientation.
