1999 NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH

To: Bureau Directors Regional Directors

Schools Superintendents

Heads of Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- In compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 647, "Declaring the Month of October of Every Year as the National Statistics Month", the Department of Education, Culture and Sports shall join all the other departments and instrumentalities of the national government in celebrating the 10th National Statistics Month (NSM) this October under the auspices of the National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB). The overall theme is "Pananaliksik, Pagsasanay at Edukasyon sa Estadistika-Kaagapay sa Pagsulong sa Bagong Siglo,"
- The observance of this event is primarily aimed at inculcating greater public 2. awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of society. Relative to this, the NSCB has issued Memorandum Circular No. 02-99 enjoining all government agencies, both at the national and subnational levels, to actively participate in and support this undertaking.
- In this connection, it is requested that DECS Regions 1, 5, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12 and CAR coordinate with the Regional Statistical Coordination Committees (RSCCs) thru the NSCB Regional Units (RUs) while the other DECS regions are requested to coordinate with RSCCs headed by either the NEDA Regional Director (RSCC Chairman) or the National Statistics Office (NSO) Regional Administrator (RSCC Co-Chairman) for the NSM activities in the regions. The DECS regional activities during the month long celebration to be included in the NSM Calendar of Activities should be submitted to the Office of Planning Service, DECS, UL Complex, Pasig City, or direct to the 10th NSM Secretariat (address indicated in the attached NSCB-NSM Form I) on or before August 15, 1999 using the inclosed suggested format.
