DECS NATIONAL CLEAN UP WEEK

- To Regional Directors Schools Superintendents
- In support of the Kalinisan, Kalusugan, Kaunlaran (KKK) Program implemented in DECS in close coordination with Procter and Gamble, Philippines, DOH, PAMET, UNICEF and other partners agencies, the 3rd week of August (August 15 21) is hereby designated and declared as DECS National Clean Up Week to further heighten awareness to the program, and to re inforce the importance of personal hygiene as well as keeping our surroundings clean
- 2 The following activities are suggested to be undertaken during the week
 - > Information campaign on personal hygiene, environmental sanitation and on the prevention and control of dengue fever, typhoid, cholera, respiratory diseases, intestinal helminthiases, among others,
 - > (Tleaning of the office, school and community surroundings, Daily health inspection of children re personnel cleanliness
 - > Integration of the KKK concepts in the elementary and secondary curricula.
- 3 All regional directors are instructed to give their full support to the activities planned by the regional/division health and nutrition units/sections, in coordination with the Working Committees on Health and Nutrition
- A brief consolidated narrative and pictorial report on the Clean Up Week shall be integrated in the $3^{\rm rd}$ Quarter Report to be submitted by the Regional Health and Nutrition Unit to the Health and Nutrition Center DECS
