CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE ON THE REVIEW OF EXISTING POLICIES ON PRESCHOOL EDUCATION

To

- 1. Batas Pambansa 232 defines elementary education as the first stage of compulsory, formal education primarily concerned with providing basic education and usually corresponding to six or seven grades, including <u>preschool programs</u>. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) recognizing the importance of preschool education has issued policy documents encouraging public and private sectors to organize preschool classes. Corollary to this, standards were set on the organization and operation of preschool classes.
- 2. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) has been implementing two (2) major programs namely: the DECS Preschool Program and the Preschool Service Contracting scheme. These programs are implemented to provide preschool experiences to the disadvantaged children in the SRA divisions in the 5th and 6th class municipalities and urban poor areas of the country.
- 3. For an effective implementation of the DECS initiated preschool programs, there is a need to review the existing policies on preschool education. In line with this, the BEE will conduct a two-day Consultative Conference at the Richville Mansion Apartelle, EDSA, Mandaluyong City on August 19 and 20, 1999.
- 4. The conference aims to discuss the issues and concerns on Preschool Service Contracting Scheme and to review the Standards on the Organization and Operation of Preschools with the following activities:

Day 1 - August 19, 1999

Discussion on the implementation of the Preschool Service Contracting Scheme.
