**PHILIPPINE NATIONAL YOUTH GAMES
(BATANG PINOY) NATIONAL TECHNICAL AND
WORK COMMITTEES WORKSHOP**

1. The Philippine National Youth Games dubbed as Batang Pinoy will be held on November 28 to December 5, 1999 to be hosted by DECSRO VI specifically the Province of Negros Occidental and Bacolod City.
2. To ensure effective and efficient implementation of the project, a national Technical-Seminar Workshop shall be conducted jointly by the DECS, PSC and NSA's on August 26 to 29 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
3. The purpose of the Technical-Seminar Workshop is to finalize the general guidelines for participation and management of the project. The following technical guidelines shall be finalized.
 - 3.1 Participation rules for Regional/Provincial/City delegations
 - 3.2 Format of competition by sports events
 - 3.3 Technical game rules based on International and local ground rules per sport
 - 3.4 Facilities and equipment per sport
 - 3.5 Schedule of competition/color schemes
 - 3.6 Eligibility requirement
 - 3.7 Designation of minimum number of Technical Officials and support staff
 - 3.8 Support services such as results gathering, awarding of medals, computerization, media center, etc.
 - 3.9 Budget and financial requirements
 - 3.10 Other related matters

4. Participants to the seminar-workshop are as follows:

5. Board and lodging of DECS participants shall be charged against BPES-DECS funds while PSC and NSA's shall be charged to PSC funds. Transportation shall be charged against the respective local funds of participants while supplies and materials and other related expenses shall be charged to PSC.

6. Likewise, a Working Committee Work-Conference will be held in Bacolod City on September 2 to 4, 1999 to finalize plans for the hosting of the said event. Participants are the key officials of DECSRO VI, Division of Negros Occidental and Bacolod City and officials from private schools and colleges, national and local government agencies in Bacolod City as well as civic and private organization involve in hosting the said national event. The Office of the Governor of Negros Occidental and the Philippine Sports Commission shall determine the participants.

DECS participants are the 16 Regional PESS Chiefs and 14 BPES Staff. Transportation expenses shall be charged against local funds.

The PSC shall take care of board and lodging of non-Bacolod City/Negros Occidental participants from DECS, PSC and NSA. Local officials/participants shall be on the live-out scheme, however snacks and lunch will be provided by PSC and or the host local government.

7. Seminar-workshop output shall be submitted to the Chairman of PSC and DECS Secretary for confirmation during the closing ceremonies of both occasions.
