### READING EDUCATION TRAINING PROGRAM (RETP) REVIEW, MONITORING AND PLANNING AND TRAINERS ENHANCEMENT WORKSHOP

To: Regional Directors

**Bureau Directors** 

Schools Division Superintendent

- 1. The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) and the Staff Development Division, Human Resource Development Service (SDD-HRDS) will conduct the *Reading Education Training Program (RETP) Review, Monitoring and Planning and Trainers Enhancement Workshop* on September 13-17, 1999 at NEAP, Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The workshop intends to: (a) review and evaluate the curriculum design and training delivery models of RETP Batch 1; (b) monitor the post-training implementation of action plans; (c) formulate appropriate strategies in implementing RETP Phase 2 and in conducting RETP Batch 2 in Summer 2000; and (d) enhance existing skills and competencies of RTWG reading trainers. As a special feature of the workshop, sessions on trainer skills enhancement will be conducted by Mr. Andrew Williams, a Reading Specialist, courtesy of the British Council.
- 3. The trainers' workshop also aims to draw up the framework and initial materials for the Reading Teachers' Handbook which will contain exercises and structured learning experiences for classroom use. These handbooks will be made available to public elementary and secondary schools as part of the long-term efforts of DECS to contextualize and indigenize teaching materials in Reading.

- 4. The following are the expected participants to the workshop: three (3) members of the Regional Technical Working Groups (RTWG) two (2) from the regional office, one (1) from the COE/TEI who was involved in the Summer 1999 RETP; 1 representative each from BEE, BSE and NFE; 4 guests from the British Council; 5 Reading Consultants and 10 NEAP-SDD staff. Please see Inclosure.
- 5. The Regional Technical Working Groups are requested to bring the summary reports of the conduct of the summer RETP, indicating among others, facts and figures of the participants and training staff, significant features/highlights of the training, problems encountered, a team evaluation of the activity and other relevant feedback.
- 6. Expenses for travel, board and lodging of regional participants, NEAP-SDD staff, resource persons and consultants, as well as professional fees, extra essential services of staff, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses are chargeable against A.I.a.1c.1 (Training and Development Funds-HRDS). Only the per diems of participants one day before and after the workshop shall be charged against local funds. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
