1 The Philippine Librarians Association, Inc (PLAI) will hold its **Regional Assembly and Congress on Safety Management and Conservation in Libraries and Archives** at Green Heights Business and Convention Center, Diversion Road, Buhangin, Davao City on September 13, 1999

2 The three-day live-in Congress and Regional Assembly aims to

- a detect hazards and exposures in libraries and archives and the control or prevention of these occurrences,
- b provide an awareness of the conservation issues and understand its concepts, principles and practices,
- c apply preservation control measures and restoration treatments,
- d draft a conservation policy, and,
- e inform members on issues of PLAI, including plans and activities

3 Enjoyed to participate are librarians (licensed or non licensed – academic, special, public and school librarians), information officers/specialists, documentation specialists, information technology officers, teachers of library and information science, teacher librarians, archivists, record officers, curators and other personnel involved in library, records-keeping, archives and related activities

4 Registration fee is Three Thousand, Eight Hundred Pesos (P3,800 00) to cover meals and snacks, and pamphlets, brochures and other informational/instructional materials. A discounted rate of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500 00) will be accorded to those who would register on or before August 25, 1999

5 Attendance of participants from government institutions may be allowed, depending on their needs, on official time only. Those coming from private agencies shall make financial arrangements with their respective institutions.
