GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ENHANCEMENT FOR POPULATION EDUCATION IN THE SECONDARY SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Regional Secretary, ARMM
Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Population Education Program, Bureau of Secondary Education (PEP-BSE), in cooperation with Human Resource Development Service (HRDS) National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) will conduct a three-day seminar-workshop on **Gender and Development Program Enhancement for Population Education in the Secondary Schools** on September 2-4,1999 at GEMS Hotel & Conference Center, Inc., Circumferential Road, Dalig, Antipolo City.
- 2. The seminar-workshop aims to (1) demonstrate an increased understanding of gender issues and concerns that need to be addressed by population education (2) identify the factors that contribute to or block the effective implementation of the gender-sensitive curriculum in the secondary education; and (3) formulate a functional regional and divisional GAD plan.
- 3. Participants to this workshop are the DECS Regional POPED Coordinators and one (1) Divisional POPED Coordinator for each region. Participants are expected to register in the afternoon of September 1. Inclosed is the Program of Activities.
- 4. Expenses for the board and lodging of participants, training and support staff and resource persons as well as the transportation of the resource persons, training and support staff, supplies and materials, function room rentals, professional fees and extra essentials services, course kits and handouts shall be drawn from the BSE and HRDS funds for special programs. However, travel expenses and per diem of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. Full cooperation and participation of all concerned and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
