**AN ECHO OF THE 12<sup>TH</sup> WORLD CONGRESS OF THE ASSOCIATION

- 1 The Linguistic Society of the Philippines, the affiliate association of AILA in the Philippines, and the Regional Language Centre Alumni Association of the Philippines (RELCAAP) are proud to announce an echo of the 12<sup>th</sup> Congress of Applied Linguistics which was held in Tokyo Japan on August 1 – 6 1999. The echo will be held live in style on December 9 – 10 1999 in GSP Camp Maria Makiling Los Baños Laguna with the theme "The Roles of Language in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century".
- 2 Some who attended and participated in the Tokyo AILA Congress will present papers at this echo namely Dr Anne Pakir of the National University of Singapore Dr Peter Lowenberg of the University of San Jose California Prof Paul Yongrae of Seoul Korea Dr Ho Mian Lian of Nanyang University in Singapore, Dr Yasushi Kawai of Hokkaido University, Japan and others. Sec Andrew Gonzalez and the present Director of the Regional Language Centre in Singapore Mrs Goh Chi Lan will be invited to deliver keynote addresses. Among the local experts who will also present papers read at the Congress are Dr Emma S Castillo Dr Ma Lourdes S Bautista Dr Dinah F Mindo Dr Gloria Bagungan, and Mrs Anna Maria Gloria Ward.
- 3 The echo will be a means by which papers presented and crucial issues discussed in the AILA Congress in Tokyo are disseminated to language educators and other language enthusiasts in the country.
- 4 Owing to the live in approach of the echo arrangements have been made such that participants could have a place to stay in the designated site. The schedule of fees is as follows:
