THIRD PRISSAAP NATIONAL CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Private Secondary School Administrators Association of the Philippines (PRISSAAP) in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education, announces the holding of its Third National Convention at the Quezon City Sports Club, E. Rodriguez Sr. Blvd., Quezon City, on November 15-17, 1999. The theme of the convention is "Quality Education: A Legacy and the Commitment of Private Basic Education."
2. The convention aims to help principals of basic education enhance their school administration and management capabilities and consequently further upgrade the quality of private basic education. The business part of the convention aims among other things to have the amendments to the PRISSAAP Constitution and by-laws ratified as well as to approve the long term plans of the Association.
3. Participants to this convention are principals and assistant principals of private secondary schools.
4. A registration fee of one thousand eight hundred pesos (P1,800.00) shall be charged each participant/observer to cover convention materials, food, rentals and other incidental expenses.
5. In view of the educational importance of this gathering to the private school administrators, this Office encourages higher school officials of private schools to allow their respective school principals and/or assistant principals to attend.
