EASTERN MINDANAO REGION INVITATIONAL SCOUT JAMBORETTE '99

- 1 The Boy Scouts of the Philippines Eastern Mindanao Region is organizing an invitational jamborette in Barangay Lunotan, Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental from November 8 13, 1999 The Jamborette venue is part of a 100 hectare forestal land being developed as a permanent site to serve as a Scout Center for Nature and Environment (SCENE)
- 2 Invited to participate in the Jamborette are Scouts an Scouters from the Eastern Mindanao Region as well as contingents coming from different local councils nationwide
- 3 The Jamborettes which has for its theme "Keeping Up for the New Millenlum", is aimed to
 - a foster the values of friendship and understanding among Scouts and Scouters through meaningful and challenging physical and conceptual activities,
 - b emphasize the pioneer role of Scouting on the importance of observing, understanding and protecting the process of nature.
 - c enhance Scouts' personal abilities and draw from it the power to set high goals and a sense of the future

SUBJECT CHANGE OF DATES - EASTERN MINDANAO REGIONAL JAMBORETTE 99

- 1 Further to Regional Memorandum No 06, dated 18 April 1999, please be informed that the Eastern Mindanao Regional Scout Jamborette has been reset to 08 13 November 1999
- 2 The Jamborette Theme is "Keeping Up for the New Millennium"
- 3 The Jamborette is aimed to
 - a Foster the values of friendship and understanding among Scouts through meaningful and challenging physical and conceptual activities
 - b Emphasize the pioneer role of Scouting on the importance of observing, understanding and protecting the process of nature
 - c Enhance Scouts' personal abilities and draw from it the power to set high goals and a sense of the future
- 4 The venue is a portion of a 100-hectare forestal land being developed as a permanent jamboree/scout center of excellence for nature and environment (SCENE). It is located some 15-km inland from Gingoog City, nestled against a backdrop of lush virgin forests and verdant mountainscapes.
- 5 Other details specified in the previous memorandum stay as is, to wit
 - Venue Bgy Lunotan, Gingoog City
 - Jamborette Fee P300 00 each participant, to cover cost of program and activity materials, administrative requirements and souvenir items
 - Contingents will bring their own cooking and camping gear (shelter, equipment) as well as
 provide their budgetary requirements for food, transportation and other expenses
 - The use of ready-made tents for shelter is encouraged
 - The climate at the jamborette site is relatively cool Participants are advised to bring thick jackets, wind breakers, raincoats and other protective clothing

- A non retundable but transferable deposit of P100 00 per participant shall be remitted to the Regional Office on or before 15 October 1999
- 7 Local Councils from other regions of the country are invited to send delegations
- Participation Requirements

For Scouts

- currently registered with BSP
- 12 to 17 1/2 years old (Boy & Senior Scouts) 17-25 years old (Rovers/Rovettes)
- holder of at least 2nd Class/Outdoorsman rank Voyager badge
- physically fit as certified by a physician
- with sufficient camping experience with approved parent s/guardian s permit
- equipped with adequate camping gear

- For Scouters currently registered with BSP
 - Preferably has taken a BTC
 - certified to have served as UL or AUL for at least two years of good moral character
 - physically fit as certified by a physician with at least two years of camping experience
 - equipped with adequate camping gear
- A wide promotion of this activity should be undertaken in order to maximize participation
