1999 LIVING VALUES: AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM (LVEP): NATIONAL EDUCATOR TRAINING

- In line with the Draft Declaration and Programme of Action on a Culture of Peace submitted 1. by UNESCO to the UN General Assembly in preparation for 2000, the International Year of the Culture and Peace and to the Declaration and Integrated Framework of Action on Education for Peace, Human Rights and Democracy, the Department of Education, Culture, and Sports (DECS), through the Teacher Education Council (TEC), UNESCO Associated Schools Project (ASP) and other nongovernment organizations, will hold the 1999 Living Values: An Educational Program: National Educator Training at Richville Mansion, 286 EDSA, Mandaluyong City on October 7-8, 1999.
- The 2-day activity aims to provide opportunity to the educators to become acquainted with Living Values: An Educational Program and Framework within which values-based learning can be implemented within a system and to train experienced educator and teacher trainers to be able to conduct LVEP in the classrooms.
- Expected participants include professional educators, teachers, trainers, education officials, psychologists and other interested parties in values-based education who already have existing skills in training adults or facilitating groups.
- A training fee of One Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (P1.900,00) will be charged per participant to cover food, accommodation, and training materials.
- Teachers from public schools may be allowed to participate on official time only. Participants from private institutions shall make arrangements with their respective offices regarding their transportation and other allowance expenses.
