SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON "BLENDING IQ AND EQ IN THE WORKPLACE: A
CHALLENGE TO THE HELPING PROFESSIONALS"

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Private Elementary and Secondary School Principals

1. The Philippine Normal University (PNU), in coordination with the Philippine Association of Psycho-Social Helping Professionals (PAPSHP), will conduct a Seminar-Workshop on "Blending IQ and EQ in the Workplace: A Challenge to the Helping Professionals" at the Adventist University of the Philippines, Puting Kahoy, Silang, Cavite on October 21-22, 1999.
2. The two-day live-in Seminar-Workshop aims to:
 - Update participants on the newest trends and development in the helping profession;
 - Use the concept of multiple intelligences in managing behavior and misbehavior in school; and,
 - Use experiential activities to enhance emotional literacy.
3. Enjoined to participate are homeroom advisers, guidance counselors and school psychologists in the elementary and secondary school levels, from public or private institutions.
4. Participants from public schools may be allowed to attend on official time only. Likewise, those coming from the private sector may make the necessary arrangements with their school administrators.

A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for accommodation, food (four regular meals), Certificates of Participation and Attendance, CPE credit units, PAPSHP regular membership, and a seminar kit containing handouts and other materials.
