NATIONAL CHILDREN S ART FESTIVAL AND CAMP

To Regional Directors
 Schools Division Superintendents
 Principals, Heads of Public and Private Elementary Schools and High Schools

- 1 The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports will host the NATIONAL CHILDREN S ART FESTIVAL AND CAMP at the National Art Center in Makiling, Los Banos, Laguna on October 21 – 24, 1999
- 2 Twelve groups of children artists from public and private schools and from indigenous communities of various regions, and about one hundred thirty PHSA students will gather together to perform, interact, engage in workshops, fora, exhibitions and other cultural activities
- 3 Activities include the oral interpretation of indigenous tales and original stories, writing and reading of Philippine stories and plays, and creative arts workshops in theater, visual arts writing, songs and dances The groups will also interact with the students from different schools in Los Banos and Region IV, NCR
