**PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF CHEMISTRY TEACHERS (PACT)
ANNUAL CONVENTION**

1. The Philippine Association of Chemistry Teachers (PACT) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, will hold its Annual Convention on October 21-22, 1999 at St. Theresa's Auditorium, Adamson University, San Marcelino Street, Manila. The theme of this year's convention is *Chemistry Education: The Challenges of the Next Millennium*.
 2. The convention aims to make the participants more aware of the challenges in chemistry education at the turn of the new millennium.
 3. Participants to this activity are chemistry teachers from both private and public high schools. Attendance shall be on official time and substitutes shall be assigned to take over the teaching loads of teachers involved in the activity.
 4. Teachers/members are invited to present demonstration lessons or conduct workshops on teaching techniques or laboratory activities. The demonstration/workshop is intended to last for three (3) hours including pre and post-activity discussions.
 5. Pre-convention/registration fees in the amount One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) and One Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (P 1,300.00) shall be charged to members and non-members, respectively, before October 8. However, after the said date, the convention fees shall be One Thousand Three Hundred (P 1,300.00) and One Thousand Six Hundred (P 1,600.00) Pesos during the convention day. Said amount shall cover the cost for seminar bag, handouts, certificate of attendance, lunch and snacks.
