- The DECS and the Asian Institute of Management (AIM) are currently working on the proposed DECS-Senior Managers Training Program (SMTP) under the DECS-Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) Policy Training and Technical Assistance Facility (PTTAF) Program for Reform in Educational System
- 2 The training which will be conducted in February 2000 will focus on enhancing the management capabilities of DECS Senior Managers in support to the thrust for decentralization of basic education management.
