11TH YMCA NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND CLUB ADVISERS SEMINAR-WORKSHOP

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Private Secondary School Principals

- 1. The YMCA of Manila will hold its 11th National Assembly of High School Students and 4th National High School Club Advisers Seminar at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on November 27-30, 1999.
- 2. The Seminar aims to: a) broaden the participants' understanding of Christian leadership and encourage them to utilize this as a basis for relevant and meaningful action; b) empower the Filipino youth through his/her acceptance of civic responsibilities and the building up of caring relationships; and, c) challenge the participants to promote initiatives as responses to the present issues and concerns affecting the people and our country.
- 3. The participants in this Assembly are selected student leaders and teacher-advisers from public and private secondary schools. Attendance at this Assembly is purely voluntary. Public school teacher-advisers should seek approval from their schools superintendents. Substitutes should be made available to handle their classes. Likewise, students shall do make up lessons in lieu of their absences from their regular classes.
- 4. A registration—fee of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (P2,700.00) shall be charged each participant to cover meals, lodging, conference materials, certificates and other expenses. Deadline for registration will be on November 17 & 20 for provincial and Metro Manila delegates, respectively. Delegates are encouraged to come with clothing fit for Eaguio climate, medicines for specific needs, camera and some souvenir items for exchange with other participants.
- 5. Attendance of teacher-participants from public schools may be allowed on official time only. Those coming from private schools shall make arrangements with their respective schools.
