SECOND NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON SPEECH COMMUNICATION

1. In celebration of its 40th year, the Department of Speech Communication and Theater Arts announces the holding of the Second National Conference on Speech Communication at the Galleria Suites Manila, #1 ADB Avenue, Ortigas Center, Pasig City on May 10-12, 2000.
