- The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA) in cooperation with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) will hold its 1999 Annual Conference-Workshop at the Auditorium of the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Maynila, Gen. Luna, Intramuros Manila on November 18-20, 1999 with the theme "Re-engineering Home Economics Education Focus on Quality Assurance of Home Economics Professionals in the Next Millennium"
- This year's annual conference-workshop shall focus on the home economics professional as educator, curriculum planner, innovator and researcher. The conference will feature lectures, panel discussions, group creative encounters and an educational tour
- Participants in this conference are Technology and Home Economics (THE) Edukasyon Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP) regional/division supervisors, administrators and chairmen, home economics heads of departments and teachers in the elementary and secondary levels in both public and private schools, teachers and deans/heads of public and private vocational schools, and deans, heads of departments and teachers in teacher training institutes who are home economists. Participants from the public schools will attend on official time only. Those from the private sector will make financial arrangements with their respective schools.
- A registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500 00) will be charged each participant to defray cost of supplies and materials and other seminar expenses such as kits, handouts, snacks and lunch Participants are likewise requested to wear Filipiniana/Regional costume at the opening ceremony and during the Cultural Night
- Attendance at this conference will be endorsed to the Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) for Continuing Professional Education (CPE) accreditation for the renewal of professional license
