

**WORKSHOP ON CURRICULUM REVIEW AND DEVELOPMENT
 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SPECIAL
 PROGRAMS IN SCIENCE AND ARTS**

- 1 The Curriculum Development Division, Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) this Department will conduct a Five-day Workshop on Curriculum Review and Development for the Implementation of the Special Programs in Science and Arts on December 6-10 1999 at Villa Virginia Resort Antipolo City
- 2 The workshop is designed to prepare a curriculum for gifted learners in Science and Arts. The participants will include consultants, writers, curriculum and arts specialists and encoders.
- 3 Expenses for the board and lodging of participants, support staff and resource persons, as well as the transportation of the resource persons and support staff, supplies and materials, function room rentals, professional fees and extra essential services, and course kits shall be drawn from the BSE funds. However, travelling expenses and per diem of the participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 4 Workshop participants are requested to proceed on December 6, 7:00 a.m. at the DECS Complex Pasig City or at the workshop site at Villa Virginia Resort, Antipolo City.
