CHILDREN BUILD BRIDGES"

The international Child Art Museum in Varby Huddinge is now organizing its 1st international art exhibition for the year 2000. The exhibition will be shown in the museum in January and February and will go on a tour in Sweden after that. Participation is open for children and young people living throughout the world. Works for the exhibition will be selected by a committee of judges.

The International Child Art Museum is an art centre for children and young people. In the centre art exhibitions are organized, training and art classes are given and international art camps are offered. There is also a large collection of children's drawings documented and available to interested.

AGE GROUPS The participants will be divided into separate age groups: 7 years, 7-9 years, 10-12 years, 13-15 years, 15 years and older.

PRIZES In each age group medals and certificates will be awarded.

JURY The panel will include wellknown artists and art educators.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS MEDIA drawing, painting, graphics etc. The size of the works may be freely decided. Pictures should be unframed. On the back of the drawing there must be information given about the artist, age, name, sex, address. Also the name and address of the teacher and school and details about the art work, title and technique etc. The works will not be returned but will instead be added to the museum's collections, that are used for further art education and research, as well as exhibitions in Sweden and other countries. The material supports children's culture and education for a multicultural world. The works should be sent by post to arrive no later than December 31 1999.
