Appendix A

GENERAL GUIDELINES

I THE CONTESTANTS

- A Each school shall have only one representative team. The team shall consist of two contestants and a coach.
- B The contestants should be currently enrolled as third year students from the high school. The coach should be a teacher of the same school.
- The participating schools are to signify their intention to join the quiz contest by sending or faxing the accomplished reply form on or before December 17 1999
- D On the day of the quiz the contestants and their coach must present their valid school ID and must be in their proper school uniform

II THE CONTEST

- A Questions in the contest will cover only those topics in high school Chemistry
- B The contest is divided into two parts the ELIMINATION and the FINALS
- C The ELIMINATION is a written exam to be taken by each contestant. This will be held in the morning of the day of the contest. The school team's score shall be computed as the sum of the individual scores of the team members.
- The ten highest scoring teams shall advance to the finals. The FINALS will be held in the afternoon of the day of the contest. It shall consist of three rounds namely the EASY DIFFICULT AND CHEMICAL CHALLENGE round.
