**FIRST NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCES
LEARNING STYLES AND ASSESSMENT**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Center for Learning and Teaching Styles, Philippines (CLTS) in coordination with the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) will conduct the First National Conference on Multiple Intelligences, Learning Styles and Assessments on February 22-24, 2000 at the New World Hotel, Makati City.

2. The objectives of the conference are to:

- a. introduce to the Philippine educational community, in particular, and to the general public, at large, the breakthrough educational theories of Multiple Intelligences (MI) and Learning Styles (LS), as well as assessment tools applying the said theories;
- b. generate awareness and up-to-date information on multiple intelligences, learning styles and emotional quotient theories; and
- c. exchange ideas on how the abovementioned theories can be translated into a theoretical framework for teaching-learning transactions and school management styles in the Philippine context.

3. Experts on multiple intelligences, assessments and learning styles have been invited as presenters in the conference. They are:

- Branton Shearer, Ph.D., author of the Multiple Intelligences Developmental Assessment Scales (MIDA)
- Richard Morales, Ph.D., a certified learning styles trainer
- Henry S. Tenedero, President of the CLTS

4. Expected participants to this conference are representative superintendents, supervisors, principals and master teachers from each region to be determined by the regional director and the superintendents. The venue can accommodate only 400 people. The exact number of participants from each region is expected to be communicated by the regions to the:

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5. The full conference registration fee is Four Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (P4,900.00). This entitles the participants to receive a complete set of workshop materials as well as breakfast, morning and afternoon snacks in the duration of the conference. Participants from public schools will attend on official time only. Arrangements for registration fees will have to be made by each participant with no use of DECS local funds.

6. Full cooperation and participation of all concerned and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
