## ANNUAL STAFF DEVELOPMENT SEMINAR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, CULTURE AND SPORTS DENTISTS ASSOCIATION (DECSDA)

- 1 The Department of Education, Culture and Sports Dentists Association (DECSDA), in cooperation with the Health and Nutrition Center of the Department announces the holding of its 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Staff Development Seminar on April 12-13, 2000 at Virginia Villas, Boracay, Aklan with the theme "DECSDA At the Threshold of its Golden Year of Service And Commitment".
- 2. The objectives of the seminar are:
  - To bring to the fore the importance of recent breakthrough and developments in the field of dentistry;
  - b. To strengthen our commitment towards effective implementation in the delivery of basic dental health services; and
  - c. To give recognition to the needs, roles and responsibilities of school dentists.
- 3. Participants to the seminar are central office and regional supervising dentists and school dentists from public and private elementary and secondary schools.
- 4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) shall be charged each participant to include board and lodging starting dinner of April 11 to breakfast of April 14, 2000, snacks, kits, certificates of participation and attendance, and other convention materials. Expenses incurred relative to their attendance in this activity are chargeable against personal/private funds.

- 5. Considering the benefits that may be gained from this staff development program, regional directors and schools superintendents are requested to encourage the public school dentists to attend. Participants from private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is expected.
