1. The Department of Education, Culture and Sports Dentists Association (DECSDA), in cooperation with the Health and Nutrition Center of the Department announces the holding of its 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Staff Development Seminar on April 12-13, 2000 at Virginia Villas, Boracay, Aklan with the theme "DECSDA - At the Threshold of its Golden Year of Service And Commitment".

2. The objectives of the seminar are:
