2) The Department of Education Culture and Sports, in collaboration with the National Federation of PTA's Foundation, Inc (NEPTA) announces the holding of the Executive Trainors Training for Parent Teacher Associations on 24 to 28 January 2000, at Teach in Camp, Baguio City. The theme of the training workshop is Parents and Teachers Building Friendships Building Bridges.

3) The trainors training workshop will serve as launching vehicle for the regional interventions on parents and teachers formation in home school collaboration, which the NEPTA hopes to start by school year 2000 - 2001. The theme shall be developed through conferences and planning workshops. The expected output is a Regional Strategic Plan for Home School Collaboration which consists in awareness and institutionalization stages.

4) Participants to this congress are two key education officials or teachers and one or two representatives from the parents sector from the region (of Enclosed roster). A total of 10 to 30 participants are expected.
