**NATIONAL CONSULTATION/REVIEW ON ZONAL OUTPUTS OF SYLLABI
PREPARATION FOR SCIENCE, ENGLISH AND MATHEMATICS**

1 The Teacher Education Council (TEC) in coordination with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) is scheduled to hold a National Consultation/Review on Zonal Outputs of Syllabi Preparation for Science, English and Mathematics on January 20-21, 2000 at the Pichville Mansion Hotel, Mandaluyong City.

2 The objective of the conference is to analyze/review the prototype syllabi for Science, English and Mathematics prepared for the CITE Project during the recently concluded zonal workshops held at Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

3 Participants to the national conference are the DECS bureau, regional and division secondary supervisor for English, Mathematics and Science, PRCB Fellows, presidents of the National Teacher Association in English, Mathematics and Science, English, Mathematics and Science specialists from the Centers of Excellence/Centers of Development (COEs/CODs) for Teacher Education, chairman and senior member of the CHED Technical Panel for Humanities, Social Science and Communication (HUSOCCM), Science and Mathematics (IPSM) and Teacher Education, permanent members of TEC from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), and Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) the regular members representing the three geographic zones, and the teacher representative for Language, Mathematics, Science and Technology and Social Studies.

4 Food and accommodation for the official participants will be shouldered by the Teacher Education Council. Transportation expense and other allowable expenses of the official participants from government institutions shall be charged against local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Those coming from private institutions shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools/offices.
