"BAGO 'YAN, AH" SCIENCE DISCOVERY RADIO PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1 This is with reference to the Science Radio show "Bago 'Yan, Ah" which is being aired over DZMM, 630 MHz every Sunday at 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

2 Bago, Yan, Ah, is a unique and pioneering kind of radio program specially designed to develop the Filipino into an information-conscious individual equipped with information on the latest scientific developments and successful transfer of technologies, using the internet as one of its major sources of information. The information also seeks to upgrade the quality of life of the Filipino in his daily chores.

3 Bago 'Yan Ah also aims to be the Media Center LINK of the different government, nongovernment organizations and individuals, specially the youth in the dissemination of related information and updates of the technologies developed in the Philippines in the hope that collaboration and coordination among these parties can speed up the progress of science effectively in schools as well as motivate the private sector to support scientific activities and projects.

4 In support of the program, all heads of schools are enjoined to encourage the students and teachers to listen to the program and utilize the information for their science projects, assignments and household chores. Any noteworthy science projects of the students, teachers and parents worth sharing with the nation are welcomed by the radio program.

5 Teachers are requested to monitor the activity and utilize the learnings from the program in their Science lessons.
